## **Field Team Responsibilities**

#### Field/ Team Responsibilities at the field: Please Check Information Table first thing every day for any updated changes.

**Our Field** - Jerome Smith Field – Located in Ptown on rt 6. Inside Ptown (walking distance from host hotel)

**Tournament Director** this year will be: Diane Beruldsen – Any problems, questions, or concerns, please go to Diane. And don't be afraid to share good comments as well.

**Assistant Director** – Tamalam Walker / Social Director – Shawna Southern / Head Official – Al Farria

**Team Photos** – 15 minutes before your first game your team photo will be taken. Please make sure it is done.

**Flag Belts** Each team is required to provide their own Flag - A-Tag WFVS Sonic Belts.

**Pennies** The tournament will supply mesh pennies to designate their 3 offensive line players. P/U @ Registration.

**Footballs** The tournament will provide the field with the official Wilson, TDJ all leather premium football.

**Player Check** - Team Line-Up Prior to Game – 10 minutes early

We ask teams to come to field 10 minutes before game time, and to line up on side line for player check: roster check, no metal cleats, shirt numbers match the roster. We truly appreciate your team's cooperation in making this pre – game check run smooth. no pockets allowed on your shorts or sports pants, and you are not allowed to tape pockets!

**Player Eligibility** - The tournament will keep rosters handy at the field in case there is a dispute for an illegal player. Any concerns about an opposing team may be brought up with tournament director and roster checked immediately. **Designated Voter** Each team has one person to vote for their team and opposing team's MVP offense and defense, nominate all stars and to also rate the official's performance of the tournament. Score cards may be picked up and need to be returned immediately at the information table (so we can put the scores up!).

All Star Nominations - Teams nominate all star positions. If you have a nomination, write on back of score card. Include Name (or shirt number), Team, Position. Don't forget to notice ALL positions. Team coaches may be asked to finalize the all star teams at end of tournament (it is a team effort by all the teams to decide)

**No Switching Shirt Numbers** – Make sure you wear the shirt number given on your team roster.

**Chain Gang** – We have a chain schedule included in the tournament schedule. Teams are responsible for holding chains. There are 2 teams designated for each game. First team slotted holds chains first half. Second team slotted holds 2nd half. This is so teams can get ready for next game and not interfere w/ warm-ups.

**Parking Meters** – At parking area do not have to be fed, make sure you have our IWFFA free parking pass.

**What's at the field?** - There is no food or water at the field, please bring your own! Bring 10 x 10 tents for shade.

**Half Time Games** – Kick / Pass / Punt – prizes to winners during half time – headed by our social director: Shawna.

**Merchandise** – Will not be at the field. Anyone wishing to purchase should contact office of IWFFA prior to the tournament to order and will be sold at Registration Party. IWFFA sweatshirts, tee shirts, footballs, kicking tees & more.

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## **Field Team Responsibilities**

**Liquor on the field** - We strictly enforce the law and prohibit consumption of any alcoholic beverages on the public field. Violators will be given a summons and asked to leave the premises if caught drinking alcohol at field.

**Keeping it Clean on the fields** - We greatly appreciate your thoughtfulness and help. Please throw garbage in cans.

**Goal Posts** – This year we have improvised a "2 x 4 "system to make kicking field goals and extra points

easier. Many thanks to Cornwell Lumber for setting this up who are our field sponsors .
