

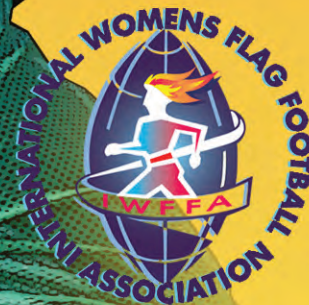

Welcome everyone to the 21st Kelly McGillis Classic International Women's Flag Football Championship and World Challenge V Game. Our first of a circuit of sanctioned IWFFA tournaments for year

2012, and the first time the tournament will be hosted outside Key West, FL. in beautiful Cocoa Beach, FL.

The organizers are founders of the Orlando Women's Flag Football League: Mary Angelini, Eduardo Gonzalez and Jaime Albury. The first two are also Porter Wilson recipients, who have done so much for women's flag football through the years, and together all three have worked hard to produce our most popular competition. You will notice that our organizers have incorporated some new ideas and procedures for the tournament, adding their own flavor to enhance the event. Bringing in new energy and new ideas after twenty years was one of the goals to offer the Kelly McGillis Classic to other cities. The organizers have done a great job and we are thrilled to offer our teams and players this new experience.

As the tournament takes place, the IWFFA has restructured, organizing committees of women to focus on a variety of projects in order to further advance the sport around the world. For better communication with our flag football players we have expanded our communications. Every third Thursday of each month, "On the Air" is our very own radio show where we interview players, celebrities and discuss some sensitive and interesting topics related to female flag football. "Flag Football News" is emailed directly to our players each month, providing current flag football information. Also, the IWFFA now produces twice a year a spring and winter edition of the "Forward Pass Magazine". The Forward Pass highlights interesting stories of our flag football players from other countries, recognizes women who have started their flag football

leagues "founding mothers" and features the achievements of our female athletes. It is the very first female flag football magazine and has become very popular especially with our international teams. These accomplishments, concerted efforts of our players, are just a few of the successes of the IWFFA.

The goals of the IWFFA: unite female flag football teams and leagues under one umbrella, standardize the rules for women's flag football, rank teams nationally and internationally, introduce the sport in countries where it does not exist, support existing teams and leagues and to professionalize the sport are reminders for the magnitude and scope of the IWFFA. The IWFFA uses the sport to teach females' leadership skills to further female influence in world affairs. We are a woman's movement as well as a sports organization. Our emphasis is not put upon winning, but more important is to learn from the challenges that present itself on the field and to transfer those experiences to every day life. Human beings can learn so much from losing. We encourage women to become leaders and have stated clearly that women should rule their own sport. 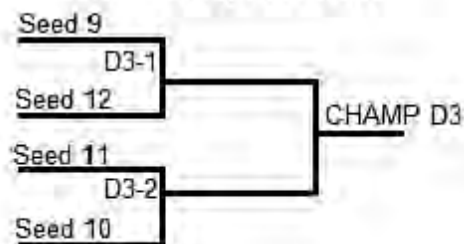
Division 1 Playoff Bracket

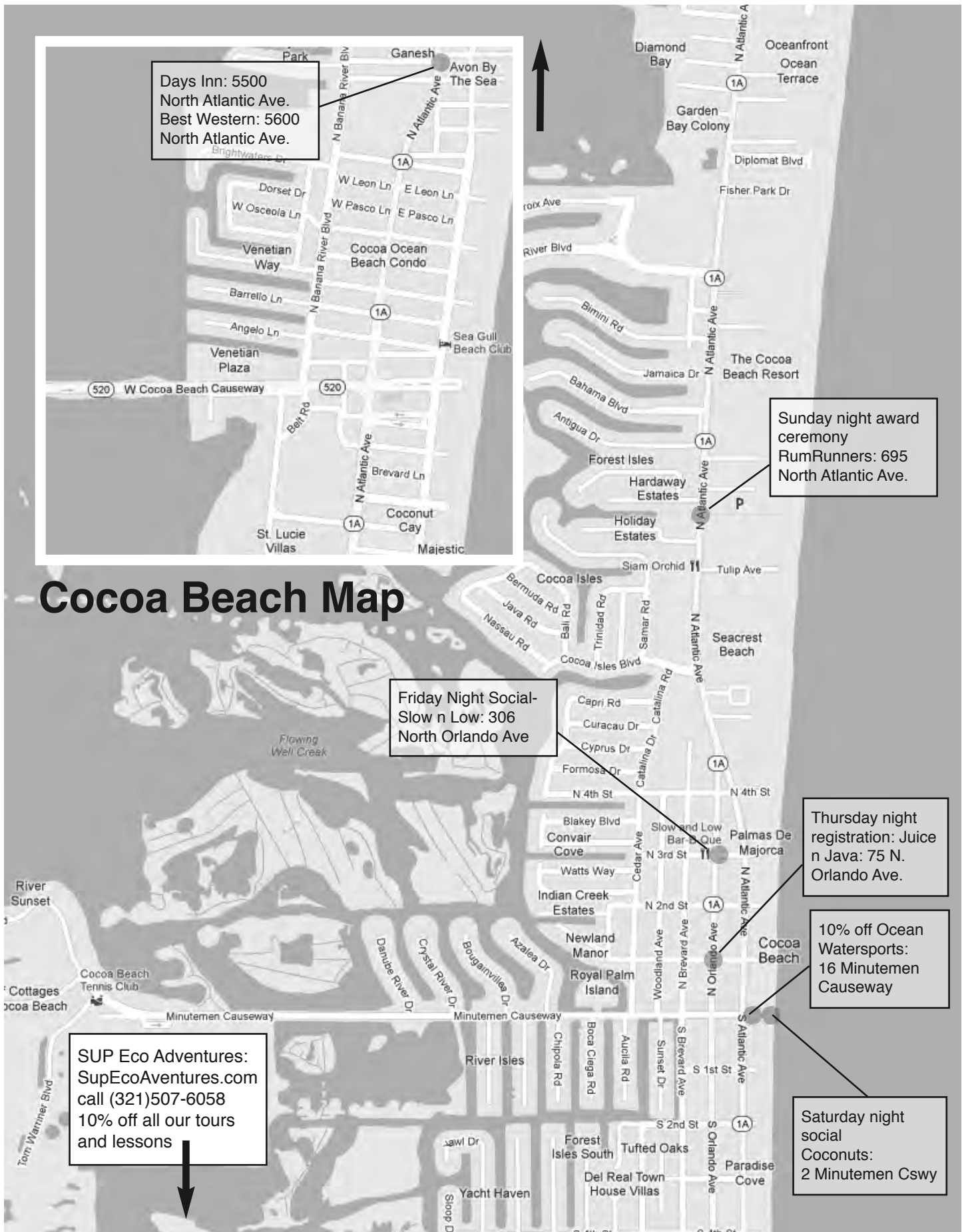

Kelly McGillis Classic History

The International Women's Flag Football Association (IWFFA) is the umbrella organization for women and girls flag football teams around the world. The IWFFA began hosting this international tournament in 1991 in Key West, Florida. The tournament now brings hundreds of players and spectators from all over the world to participate and watch the largest international women's flag football tournament in the world.

In 2011, the IWFFA opened bidding for its 2012 tournament to another region. Blue Wave along with the Orlando Women's Flag Football League, who has participated in past IWFFA tournaments, won the bid to host this international tournament in Cocoa Beach, Florida.



About the Orlando Women's Flag Football League...

The Orlando Women's Flag Football League (OWFFL) was founded by Mary Angelini. The League was established in 2010, and is the only all women's flag football league in Central Florida. Their season runs during late fall/early winter in the Orlando area. There are hopes to expand into a Spring season in the upcoming years as the organization grows.

About The Organizers...

Diane Beruldsen: President & Founder of the IWFFA. She lives, eats and breathes flag football. Diane created the Kelly McGillis Classic and organized the first 20 years. She has dedicated her life to spreading female flag football around the world. Currently she lives in Norway to increase flag football in Scandinavia and promote in Europe. She joins us for the 21st Kelly McGillis Classic.

Eduardo Gonzales: Coach for the Blue Wave Football Club based in Melbourne, FL and IWFFA Porter Wilson Award Winner. He is the Field Manager and one of the tournament's main organizers. He also created the Ultimate Team Competition and manages the after parties events. He is the go-to guy for scheduling and field/referee management.

Jamie Albury: The organizational specialist of this event, she is in charge of the new online registration system and managing the teams after they have registered. She has participated in 3 IWFFA tournaments as a member of the Blue Wave team and is now "retired" from playing football.

Mary Angelini: OWFFL President and Blue Wave player. She has played competitively for over 11 years, participated in 7 IWFFA tournaments and is a Porter Wilson Award winner. She is a women of many trades and has been involved in all aspects of the tournament.
