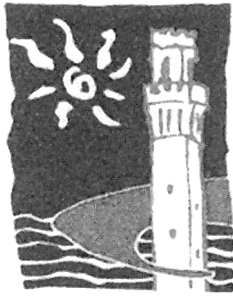

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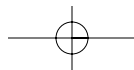

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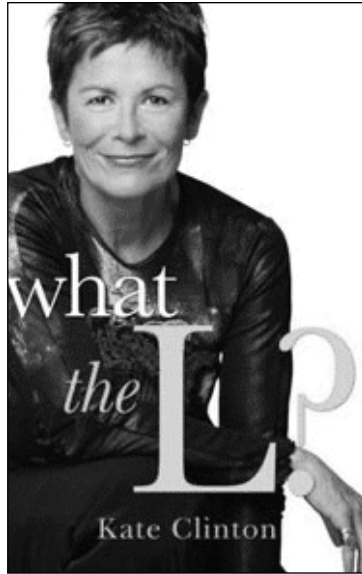

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### ***Field/ Team Responsibilities:***

**Please Check Information Table first thing every day for any updated changes**

**Field Location:** Wellsfleet Recreational Field- It is off of Rt. 6 (15 minute drive from Ptown) and you will get exact directions at Meet & Greet

#### **Flag Belts**

Each team is required to provide their own Flag - A-Tag WFVS Sonic Belts. You may purchase belts at our information table, but supplies are limited. To order call: Flag - A-Tag at: 800-527-7510 # 7433, or go directly through office of IWFFA for greater discount rates.

#### **Pennies**

Teams need to supply their own to designate their 3 offensive line players. We suggest you use the mesh type to show player numbers and sleeveless, so they are not so hot. If you do not have your own, you may purchase at Meet & Greet from Stephanie Miller.

#### **Footballs**

We use a tournament game ball, provided by the IWFFA. Teams are NOT allowed to exchange balls (even for kicks).At end of game, make sure Head Official receives the

tournament ball, or else your team will have to pay for it. Please be careful.

Footballs may be purchased thru the IWFFA office: 35 for IWFFA members /\$40 to non-IWFFA members and will be available at the field.

#### **Designated Voter – Score Cards – Turning Them In**

Each team has one person to vote for their team and opposing team's MVP offense and defense and to also rate the official's performance of the tournament. Score cards are be picked up and returned at the information table.

#### **Chain Gang**

We have asked for local volunteers to do chains for this tournament, but at time of printing, the tournament may not provide people to run the chains. Therefore, as in the past, each team is responsible to provide two volunteers to run the chains during their own game (or immediately after their own games and will follow a schedule for the Chains – we will decide at Captains meeting during Meet & Greet)

#### **Water for the players**

We will supply 5 gallons of water for each side line, but not the cups. Bring your IWFFA water bottles, which each registered participant will receive at the Meet & Greet. Otherwise, the water bottle can be bought for \$5.00 at the field.

We strictly enforce the law and prohibit consumption of any alcoholic beverages on the public field. Violators will be given a summons and asked to leave the premises if caught.

**Side Lines**

Teams are responsible for their sidelines or else they will be penalized. This includes behavior of their team and their fans. 15 yard penalty for unsportlike behavior.

# Itinerary

## Flag Football Clinic for local Girls and Boys

Tuesday and Wednesday before the tournament, IWFFA President, Founder and Trainer, Diane Beruldsen, will instruct the 1st flag football clinic offered to girls and boys at Wellfleet Elementary and Middle Schools. Ms. Beruldsen has traveled the world to promote and start teams and leagues of female athletes throughout the US, Canada, Europe and Scandinavia. The IWFFA was the organization that actually introduced the sport of Flag Football in the Scandinavian Countries, where the Nordic Women's Flag Football League exists today.

During the two day clinic, between 2:30 – 4PM (Elementary School) and 4:30 – 6PM (Middle School), the children will learn basic, organized, flag football skills and drills to prepare them for their own game during the Kate Clinic Classic Women's Flag Football in the: "Battle of the Sexes". It will be the Girls against the boys (and we know who will win) who will play Friday, September 22 and Saturday, September 23 to demonstrate their skills and have some fun. The IWFFA will also donate the balls and equipment to the school and hope to initiate a local girls and boys league in Wellfleet.

**Battle of the Sexes Tournament Games – Girls against the Boys!**  
Tentatively, the games will be scheduled as follows: Elementary School Children ages 9 – 11 girls vs. boys will play Friday, 2:30 – 3:30PM at the Wellfleet Field, and the Middle School girls vs. boys ages 12 – 14 yr will play Saturday at 9:00AM We encourage everyone to come on out and cheer them on! Many thanks to Becky Rosenberg, Director at Wellfleet Baker fields, for all her assistance in making this event happen and good luck to all the players!

## Free Shuttle Service for Players

Free Shuttle Service to Players: We offer a Van to shuttle players who do not have a car. We will meet outside Host Hotel: Pilgrim House to pick up players and drive to field. There is no time slot, just make sure you tell Julian the weekend shuttle driver that you need a ride. We are NOT responsible if you do not make it to game on time, so please give yourself enough time to travel and make your arrangements with Julian the day before you need to travel. This is one van, and if many players are needing a ride, then be careful with your arrangements to make sure you get to field on time.

During the Games: We will supply water at each side line during the tournament, but players must bring your IWFFA water bottles to drink out of (no cups will be supplied). Each player will receive their water bottle at the Meet & Greet when each player officially registers.

## Letter from the President

Since 1997, the International Women's Flag Football has worked hard to promote, organize, develop and bond female flag football players not only in the US, but around the world. Around the world.... imagine that.

How many other sports organizations in the US actually travel, introduce, create and form leagues of women athletes in other countries, and then tie them together with our leagues?

We are unique, and we must understand that this organization is run by women, for women.

I never really understood why the men feel so strong about taking control of women sports. They do. And female athletes allow them. Here, in this organization, we want the women to play, officiate, manage, and coach the sport. In officiating, we offer female players the chance to get on the field, during a tournament, and to practice freshly learned officiating skills, in order to develop into a fine Official. We offer individual women who have never played before the opportunity to play on our Loose Women's teams, no matter if they are athletic or not, and we give all the Loose Women equal time on the field. It does not matter if we win or loose, but rather, that every one plays the same amount of time and learns from it all... and have fun! We INVITE female players and any female for that matter. We embrace, nurture and support the women to do this. What other sports organization does this?

Our office has served as a source of information regarding flag football to many groups, offering information on it's history, where to play in one's area, how to start a team or league, clinics, recruitment of players, etc. There is no other flag football organization that does this.

When you pay your membership dues, you are supporting an organization that

is unique, works hard and is well deserving of your support. Please extend yourself, and think of what you can do as well to take us farther. Your energy, your good will and your physical and spiritual support will make a tremendous difference not only for the IWFFA... but for yourself.

I hope you truly enjoy your time here in the Cape. The location, had been thought of for many years, and finally, it was over five years ago, when we met with the township and started making plans to create this tournament, just for our female athletes. 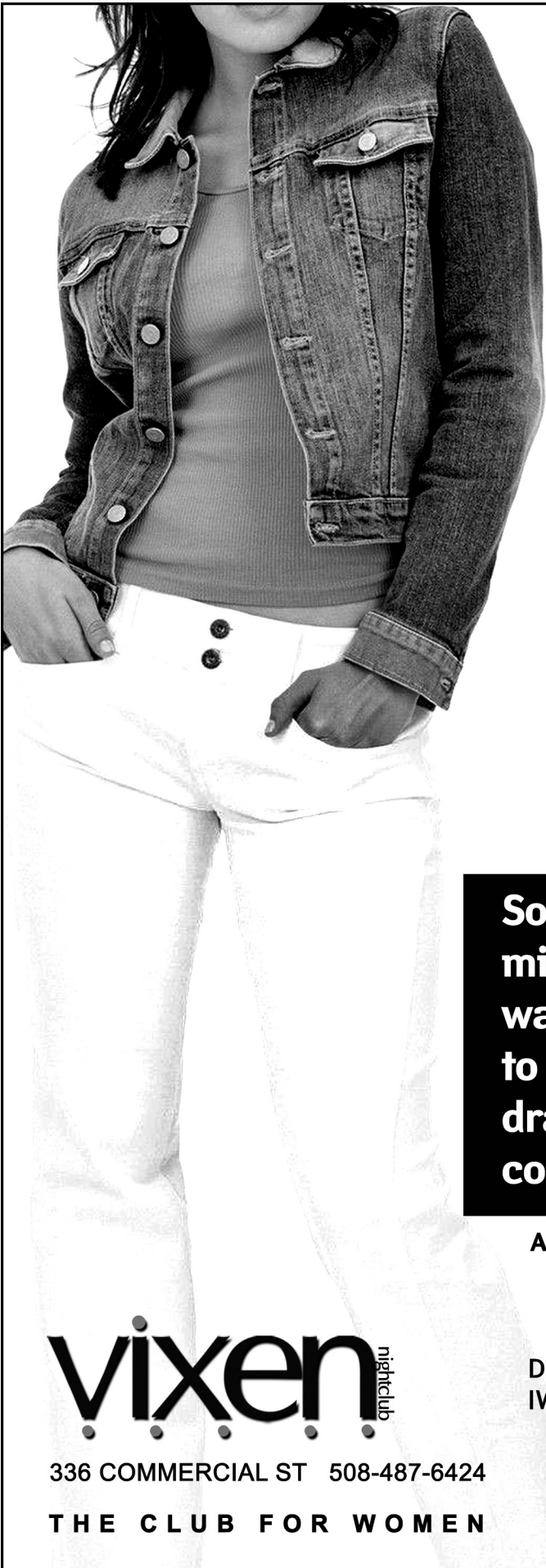
