Field/ Team Responsibilities at the field:

- Please Check Information Table first thing every day for any updated changes-

Tournament Director this year will be: Diane Beruldsen, President Founder of IWFFA – Any problems, questions, or concerns, please go to Diane. And don't be afraid to share good comments as well.

Head Official – Georgeann Lewis & Tournament Officials: Mark Walker, Jane Eldredge and Shawna Southern

Team Photos – 15 minutes before your first game your team photo will be taken. Please make sure it is done.

Flag Belts Each team is required to provide their own Flag - A-Tag WFVS Sonic Belts.

Pennies Teams need to supply their own to designate their 3 offensive line players. We suggest you use the mesh type to show player numbers and sleeveless, so they are not so hot.

Footballs The tournament will provide the field with the official Wilson, TDJ all leather premium football.

Player Check - Team Line-Up Prior to Game – 10 minutes early

We ask teams to come to field 10 minutes before game time, and to line up on side line for player check: roster check, no metal cleats, shirt numbers match the roster. We truly appreciate your team's cooperation in making this pre – game check run smooth. no pockets allowed on your shorts or sports pants, and you are not allowed to tape pockets!

Designated Voter Each team has one person to vote for their team and opposing team's MVP offense and defense and to also rate the official's performance of the tournament. Score cards may be picked up and need to be returned immediately at the information table (so we can put the scores up!).

All Star Nominations - This year, we allow teams to nominate all star positions. If you have a nomination, write on back of score card. Include Name (or shirt number), Team, Position. Don't forget to notice ALL positions

No Switching Shirt Numbers - Some teams have two sets of shirts, so that if they come up against a team with same color shirt, they use their 2nd set. But, if you switch colors, make sure you keep same number. You must keep shirt number you have on your roster

Chain Gang - Each team is responsible to provide two volunteers to run the chains during their own games. Please have your chain people report to the head official 10 minutes prior to game time to acknowledge that they will do the chains. Or, we will use a different chain system and create a schedule, in which teams will be responsible for holding chains following their own games. We will decide at meet & greet captain's meeting. Which ever system we use, we appreciate your cooperation to ensure that the games will run smoothly and on time.

Our Field - Jerome Smith Field – Located in Ptown on rt 6. Inside Ptown (you can walk to the fields)

Parking Meters – will be at the field and you do not have to put any money in them during our tournament games.

What's at the field? - There is no food or water at the field, please bring your own!

ELLEN DANCE! – Once again, as in all our IWFFA 2010 flag football tournaments we will dance, film, cut and edit and present to Ellen Degeneres. All teams are asked to join in . We will post on website and You Tube

Half Time Games – Kick / Pass / Punt – prizes to winners during half time

Liquor on the field - We strictly enforce the law and prohibit consumption of any alcoholic beverages on the public field. Violators will be given a summons and asked to leave the premises if caught drinking alcohol at field. Some of our prizes may be liquor or beer, but they should be consumed elsewhere (for more enjoyment)

Keeping it Clean on the fields - We greatly appreciate your thoughtfulness and help.




